EOI's will focus on the title of this session within the context of Urban or Rural or Remote. Each presentation will be 10-15 minutes.

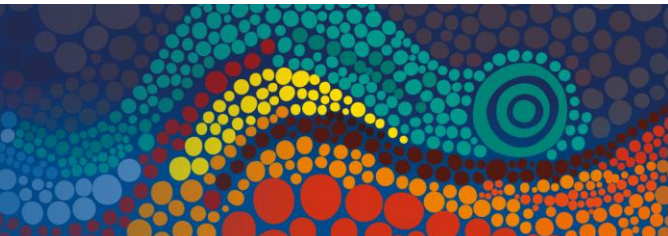
Concurrent Session 2 (3.30 - 4.00pm) – Workforce Innovation, Challenges and Opportunities.
